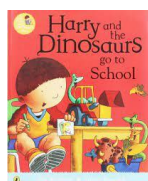
Topic

Who lives in my house?

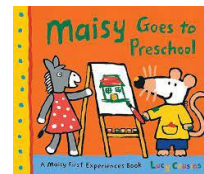
This half term our topic is, 'Who lives in my house?'.

We will talk about the people who live in our houses and the people who are important to us. We will talk about special people in our families. We will explore different types of houses and materials used for making houses. We will explore what it is like around our houses and the local environment. We will think about the people that might visit our houses including people who help us.

Communication & Language / English



This half term we will reading lots of different stories as well as having a focus on Nursery Rhymes.



We will be reading stories all about starting school as well as stories linked to our topic. We will have a weekly nursery rhyme focus where your child will have the opportunity to learn a variety of nursery rhymes. You will be able to send videos of your child singing nursery rhymes via class dojo.

Mathematics

This term in nursery we will be looking at counting to the number 5 and singing a variety of number songs such as 5 little speckled frogs, 5 cheeky monkeys and 5 little men in a flying saucer. We will also explore a variety of 2D shapes and look at 2D shapes we can find in our environment.

In a few weeks your child will come home with a library book. This is a book which you can read to your child. You will be given a home reading record where you can record what books you and your child are reading together at home.

Now the weather is getting colder please ensure your child has a warm waterproof coat, hat and gloves in school every day. Please label everything with your child's name.



We also have a large number of children who haven't brought in a pair of wellington boots. Please send some in as soon as possible so your child can experience outdoors in all weathers.

As we get lots of wet socks in the winter months please ensure your child has spare socks in their book bags.
