Enrichment Activity: Film Club	Description: Watch, critique, and review films	
Objectives: To successfully engage in a discussion including positive and negative aspects of a film, to successfully plan and review a selected film.	Date:	Duration:
Programme of Study: ICT, English		
Progression of Learning and Teaching: Key Teaching Points		Resources needed
Week 1: Children will agree on a film to be watched and each receive a template for a film review with the headings: Overview, Positive, Negative, Characters, Summary, and Rating. Children will think of areas of significance when reviewing a film e.g. Budget, special effects, the storyline, the acting etc and incorporate these into the relevant sections on their plans. Children will look at example film reviews and notice trends in the way they are layed out and vocabulary used. Children will watch the film and write a draft of their review. Film will be paused at significant scenes to question understanding and importance of scene, and to give opportunity to discuss/critique this scene to add to their draft reviews. Week 2: If not finished, the children will finish the film. Children will then write up their final film review on the IntoFilm.com website after having the opportunity to upstage and correct vocabulary and punctuation. The review will be available to read on the website and is automatically entered into a nationwide weekly draw for the Review of the Week.		Ipads
