Digital Leaders Meeting Minutes

Date: 6th December 2021

Attending: Digital Leaders Years 1-6

Minutes:

1. Welcome and introductions.

- 2. Discussion centred around role of Digital Leaders in class in raising the profile of Esafety, ways to keep safe and what to do if they feel unsafe when accessing the internet on various devices. Digital Leaders are aware how much time young people spend online and want to make it clear what information should NOT be shared.
- 3. Collaborative work to create the Digital Leaders' PowerPoint and catering it to each Key Stage so that the material is suitable to the pupils in those classes. Discussion about who is a friend online and what to do with requests. Young people seem to think that if they 'speak' to someone online they automatically are a friend so a slide to be included about what a friend is and how to distinguish this when online.
- 4. Discussion around cyber bullying and peer-on-peer bullying becoming more and more apparent and relevant to young people each day. Digital Leaders to talk about how this bullying is exactly the same as that which happens in person.
- 5. Presentations to take place in each class before the end of term. Teachers to support pupils with presentations in younger classes and photographic evidence to be sent to Esafety Lead. The main questions to get feedback on from classes using post it notes:
 - What are the key messages to take away from today?
 - Who can you speak to if you are worried about your safety online?
