Dear Parents and Carers,

Hope you all had a lovely half term break. It was great to see some of you at the Children's Mental Health week parent event. The children loved having you in class! Thank you to parents for your support in ensuring that your child completes their online homework and reads at home. Below are some reminders for this term of what we expect each week.

Reading: Children will take home a reading book (which will be changed weekly once they are able to read the questions based on the text— **if they cannot answer the questions they will be asked to keep the book to further develop understanding**) and an Accelerated Reader Book (these can be changed regularly after completing online quizzes in school). Pupils should be reading at home daily to help increase their pace and fluency. Please ensure you sign and date your child's reading record to show they have read at home/finished a book.

Homework: Spelling homework is accessible on Spelling Shed. The children should login Monday until Thursday night to complete activities. Times tables rock stars is the weekly maths homework and children should complete daily to practice their time-tables knowledge.

Please make sure you provide your child with the correct uniform for PE. Black shorts, pumps and a white t-shirt. A jumper and tracksuits may be needed for outdoor PE. Children are not allowed to wear any jewelry in PE so please make sure your child removes any jewelry on the mornings of PE days unless they can remove them themselves. Girls with long hair must be tied back.
