Music - finding rhythm and learning simple songs

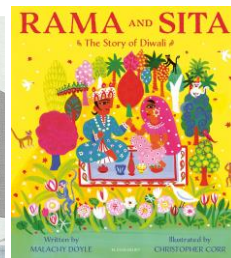
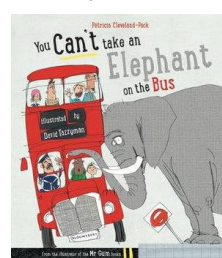
PE - Fundamental skills and dance
